Summary

- [Total number of permits](#) issued in June 2010 (751) are up from May 2010 (652). Total number of permits issued this month is up versus June 2009 (666).
- [Valuations](#) for June 2010 (\$77,123,734) are up from May 2010 (\$7,250,026).
- 1 [new single-family](#) permit was issued in June 2010.
- [Residential addition/remodel](#) permits issued in June 2010 (55) is slightly up from permits issued in May 2010 (50).
- 1 [new commercial](#) project was permitted in June 2010 This was the IKEA project
- [Plan review](#) activity for June 2010 (106) is up compared to May 2010 (85).
- [Rapid Review](#) Permit and Plan Review activity for June 2010 (50) is up compared to May 2010 (43).

Fees/Revenues

- [Fees](#) for this month of \$352,080 are above the City's projected revenues of \$177,000.
- Total Building Division fees retained by the City of Centennial as of the June billing total approximately \$304,332 which is well above the projected revenue of \$196,115 (25% of total revenue).
- [Year-to-date](#), Building Division revenues of \$1,216,521 are well above projected revenue of \$784,460 year to date.






Building Division Total Revenue






