Summary

- [Total number of permits](#) issued in June 2011 (510) are up from May 2011 (457). Total number of permits issued this month are down versus June 2010 (751).
- [Valuations](#) for June 2011 (\$12,747,003) are slightly down from May 2011 (\$12,797,734).
- 2 [new single-family](#) permit were issued in June 2011.
- [Residential addition/remodel](#) permits issued in June 2011 (63) are down from permits issued in May 2011 (76).
- 4 [new commercial](#) projects were permitted in June 2011.
- [Plan review](#) activity for June 2011 (203) is up compared to May 2011 (153).
- [Rapid Review](#) permit and plan review activity for June 2011 (67) is down compared to May 2011 (85).
- [Total Contractor license](#) Issued in June 2011 (1080) are up from May 2010 (88)

Fees/Revenues

- Building [Fees](#) for this month of \$158,204 are below the City's projected revenues of \$160,000.
- [Contractor license Fees](#) for this month of \$112,295 are above the City's projected revenues of \$83,000.
- Total Building Division fees retained by the City of Centennial as of the June billing total approximately \$229,343 which is above the projected revenue of \$192,500 (25% of total revenue).
- [Year-to-date](#), Building revenues of \$917,374 are above projected revenue of \$770,000.
- [Year-to-date, Contractor license](#) revenues of \$136,263 are above projected revenue of \$118,000


