



Asbestos Checklist

1. Is the building anything other than a single family dwelling (includes residential condominium building of ten or fewer units) (e.g. commercial, or public building, lodge, apartment, industrial facility, ect.)? _____
2. Are you removing more than a total of 160 square feet of any material besides concrete, wood, bricks, or steel (examples are drywall, linoleum, carpet, ceiling tiles, ect.) or more than 200 lineal feet of pipe? _____
3. (Roofing material that is not to be removed with power operated saws do not have to be included.)
4. Where the materials above installed prior to October 12, 1988? _____

If the answer to each of these questions in YES, you need an asbestos test before you apply for a building permit. A state certified asbestos inspector must do this test and the test report must be submitted with the building permit application. If you answer YES TO ALL THREE questions, contact a certified asbestos inspector of your choice. (See Yellow Pages)

Submit a copy of the test report to the Building Division whether asbestos was found or not. If the building has asbestos, a state certified asbestos abatement FIRM MUST REMOVE IT. After removal, the abatement firm must provide a letter to the Building Division stating that all of the asbestos has been removed and the air in the structure is clean and safe. **This letter must be received BEFORE a permit will be issued.**
