

Right of Way Permit Process

The City of Centennial requires that all contractors or entities applying for a ROW permit carry a \$20,000 non-cancelable license or permit bond, payable to the City of Centennial. All contractors performing work must also have a City of Centennial Contractor's License.

Permit Checklist:

- Completed Permit Application
- Detailed Site Plan
- MUTCD Traffic Control Plan
- Completed Use Tax Forms
- List of any subcontractors

Permit Classifications:

All permits will be classified as listed in the following table:

* Class 1 and Class 2 Permits will be issued on a walk in – walk out basis provided that all required information is provided at the time of application.

* Class 3 Permits will require the submission of construction plans, traffic control plans, and other additional information, as required.

Payment:

Payment is due at the time of issuance. Acceptable forms of payment are cash, check, Visa, or MasterCard.
