

The City of Centennial's Home Improvement Program (**HIP**) is intended to assist homeowners undertaking a qualifying home improvement project. As a thriving community of more than 100,000 residents, the City of Centennial recognizes that neighborhoods are one of our greatest assets, because they are the places families call "home." **HIP** has been established to contribute to the preservation and enhancement of our beautiful neighborhoods through **Education, Assistance** and (financial) **Incentives**.

The Building Division is available to provide consultation prior to the beginning of construction to raise awareness of life-safety issues that a home improvement project may involve, provide information about how to go about selecting and working with a contractor, and identify opportunities to find discounts on services and materials with local businesses. *The Building Division is a homeowner's resource to producing a better outcome.*



Participation in **HIP** is voluntary. To qualify: for permits with a valuation of \$15,000 or more, homeowners can receive a 20% discount on building permit fees. The City is pleased to partner with the Better Business Bureau (BBB) because of their consumer advocacy mission. The BBB provides easy access to a database of Accredited Businesses through their website at no cost.

## Discount on Building Permit Fees!



### Effective July 1, 2011:

- 20% discount on Building Permit Fees for qualifying permits
- Minimum permit valuation of \$15,000 required
- Discount is provided directly to the homeowner at the completion of the project upon issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy
- Program funding for 2012 is \$20,000 and discounts are available on a first-come basis
