Our organization had the good fortune of having an encounter with two of your Animal Services officers today. We are an all-volunteer animal rescue in Colorado and one of our dogs, Jasper, was adopted on Easter Sunday by a family from Littleton. The father works in Centennial and brought Jasper to work with him on Wednesday. When UPS visited the building, the UPS employee left the door open and Jasper escaped. Our adopters contacted us for assistance in finding a lost dog and we immediately contacted Animal Services.

Officer Sorrell responded quickly and was very helpful from the beginning. She began looking for Jasper last evening and she and Officer Kimminau continued to do so today. This morning, Officers Sorrell and Kimminau located Jasper at one point and contacted me to let me know they had sighted him and were trying to capture him. I drove out to Centennial to try to assist, but unfortunately he evaded us and took off across Jordan. They continued to look for him, notifying other jurisdictions and area businesses. Thankfully, Animal Services was notified late in the afternoon that he had been coaxed inside by a local business. Officer Sorrell quickly contacted us and let us know that he was safe and assisted in reuniting him with his family. We greatly appreciate the compassionate and professional approaches of Officers Sorrell and Kimminau. Both have outstanding work ethic and dedication to the job, which as the owner of a law firm and director of a non-profit I can say is hard to find these days. These officers are to be commended for their outstanding work and their dedication to their community.
