Re: West Centennial Paving Project

Dear Councilwoman Turley:

Several weeks ago my wife directed a telephone question to you concerning the completion schedule for paving work in our immediate neighborhood. The work crews had roto-milled several streets, and then seemed to abandon the project. When you called back, I asked that you expand the inquiry. I wanted to determine if a low spot in the gutter at the front of our property could be corrected with the other concrete work being done for the project.

You obtained and relayed to us an approximate time for completion of the paving. Although your information did not include a definitive reason for the gap between the roto-milling and the final paving, it did tell us what to expect. Your inquiry also produced a direct telephone call to me from the city's concrete supervisor.

He identified himself as "Rob", and unfortunately I failed to get his last name. He understood immediately my concern about the low spot and the problem of water accumulation there. We quickly agreed on an estimate for the amount of gutter replacement it would require to correct the problem. He sent a crew to check the estimate with a level, determine the sections to replace, and mark them accordingly.


I inspected the marked sections, and thought there might be a significant benefit to including one more section for replacement. I spoke with Rob again and explained my reasoning. He had the area rechecked with

a level, and explained why he thought the additional section did not need to be replaced. To help you understand the problem, you should know that our property is very near the peak of a modest hill. There is not very much slope for a drainage designer to work with and avoid low spots.

The old concrete was removed, and the work crew poured and finished the replacement sections. It appears they did an exceptional job. We have had only one small rain since the work was done, but I believe the drainage will be very good. It certainly will be a huge improvement. The paving crew completed the paving work one week ago.

Thank you for your response to our initial inquiry. I am very pleased with the response from Rob, and his courtesy in addressing my concern.
