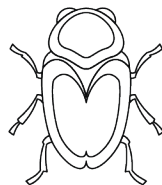
Which of these is **not** an insect? An insect is bug that has six legs and usually two or four wings.



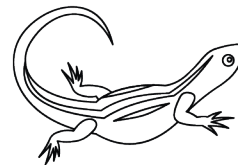

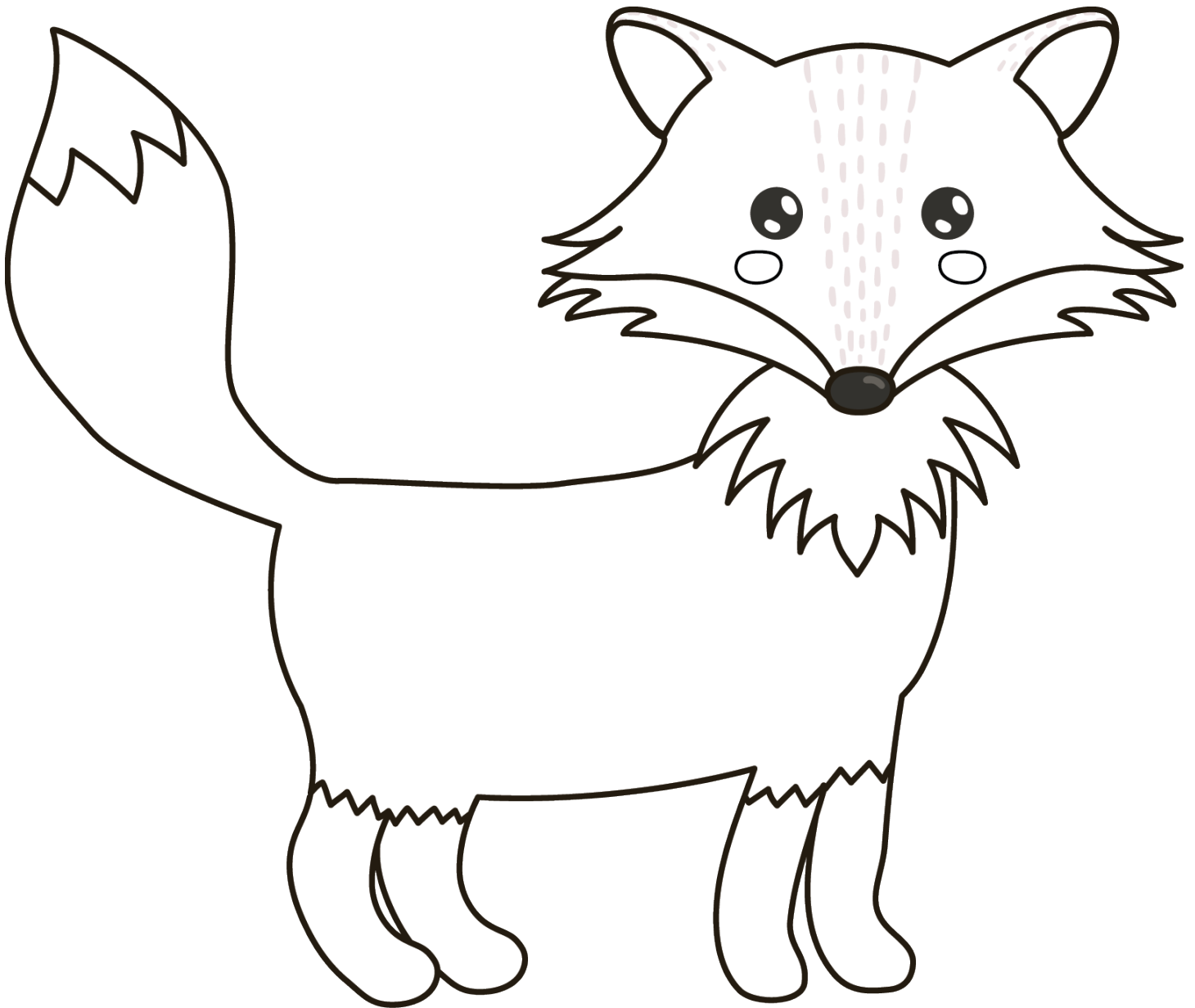




# Red Fox

color Me!

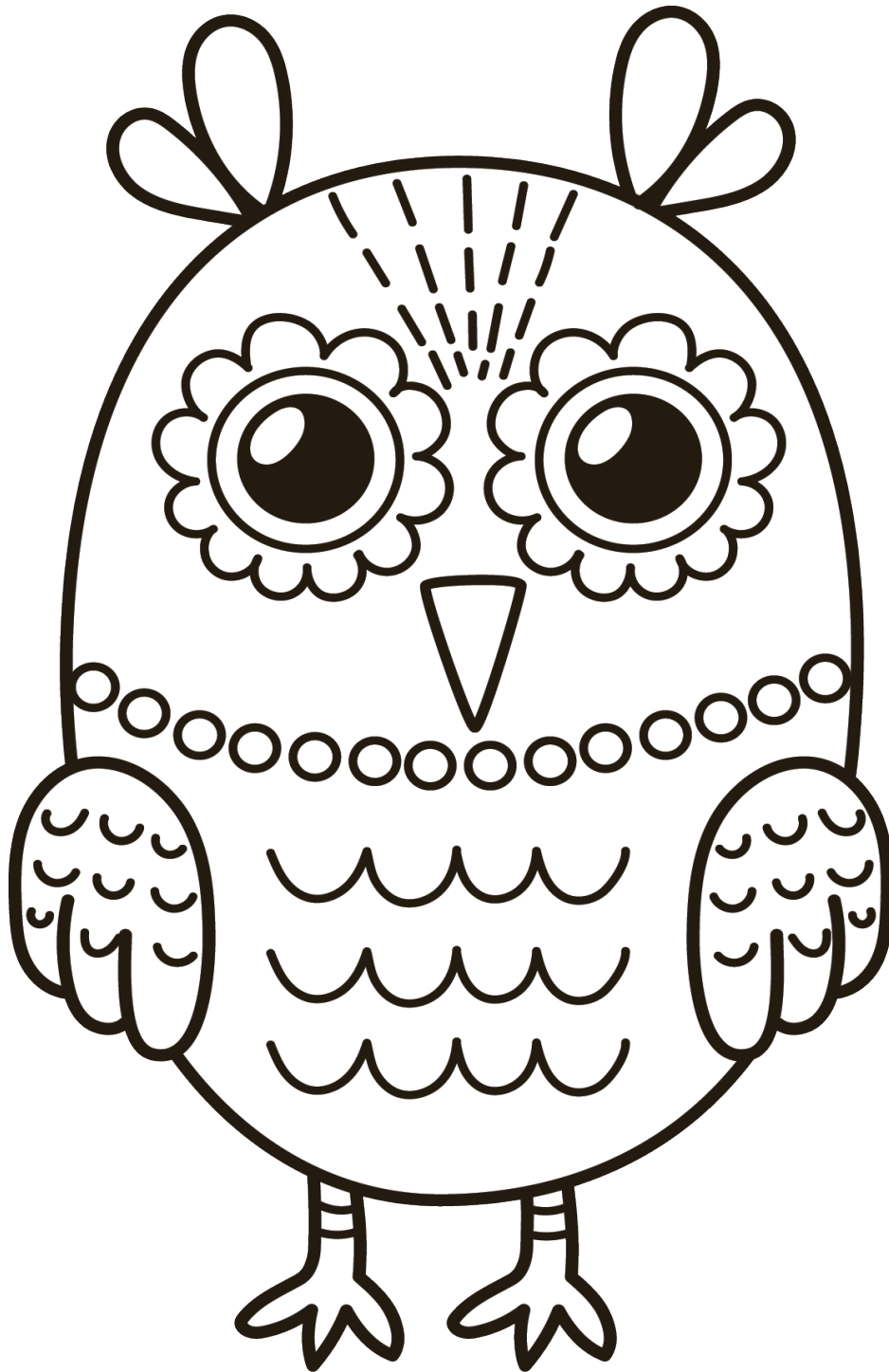
Did you know not all Red Foxes are red? Some are brown, black or even silver!

color Me!

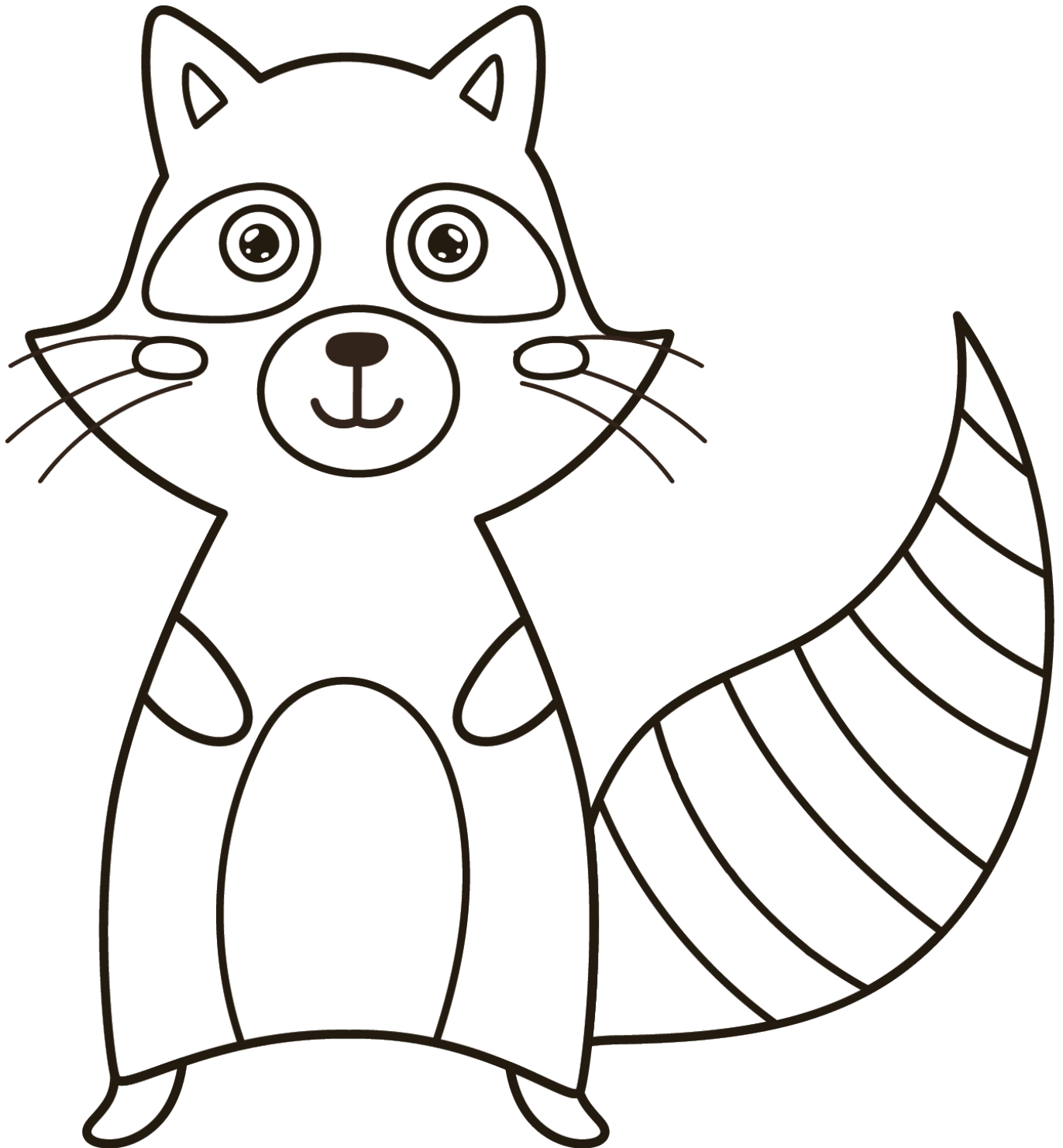
The Great Horned Owl has no horns! It's named for the tufts of feathers that sit on top of its head, called plumicorns.

Raccoons have very nimble fingers on their front feet that make it easy for them to untie knots, turn doorknobs and even open jars!

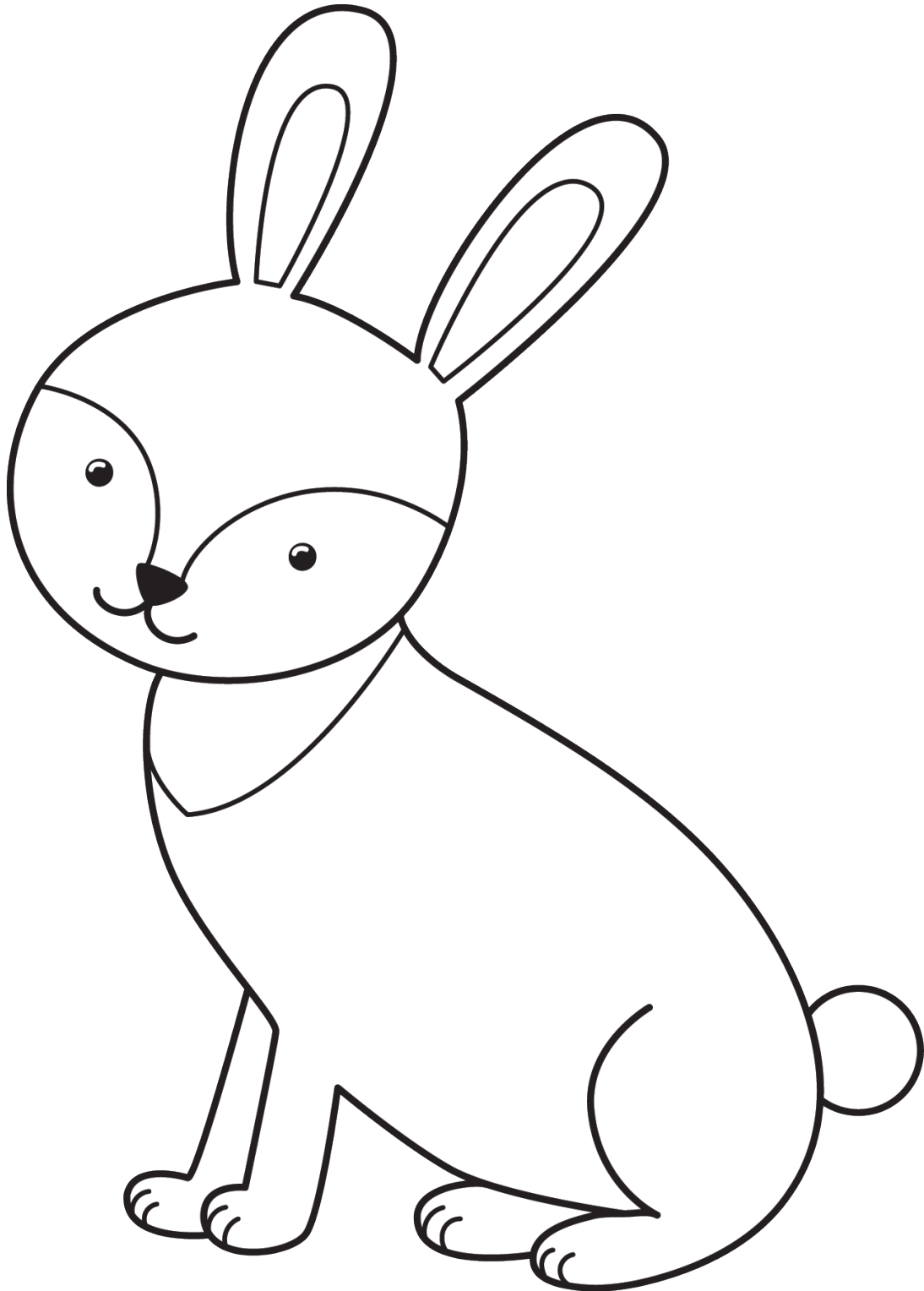




# Cottontail Rabbit
