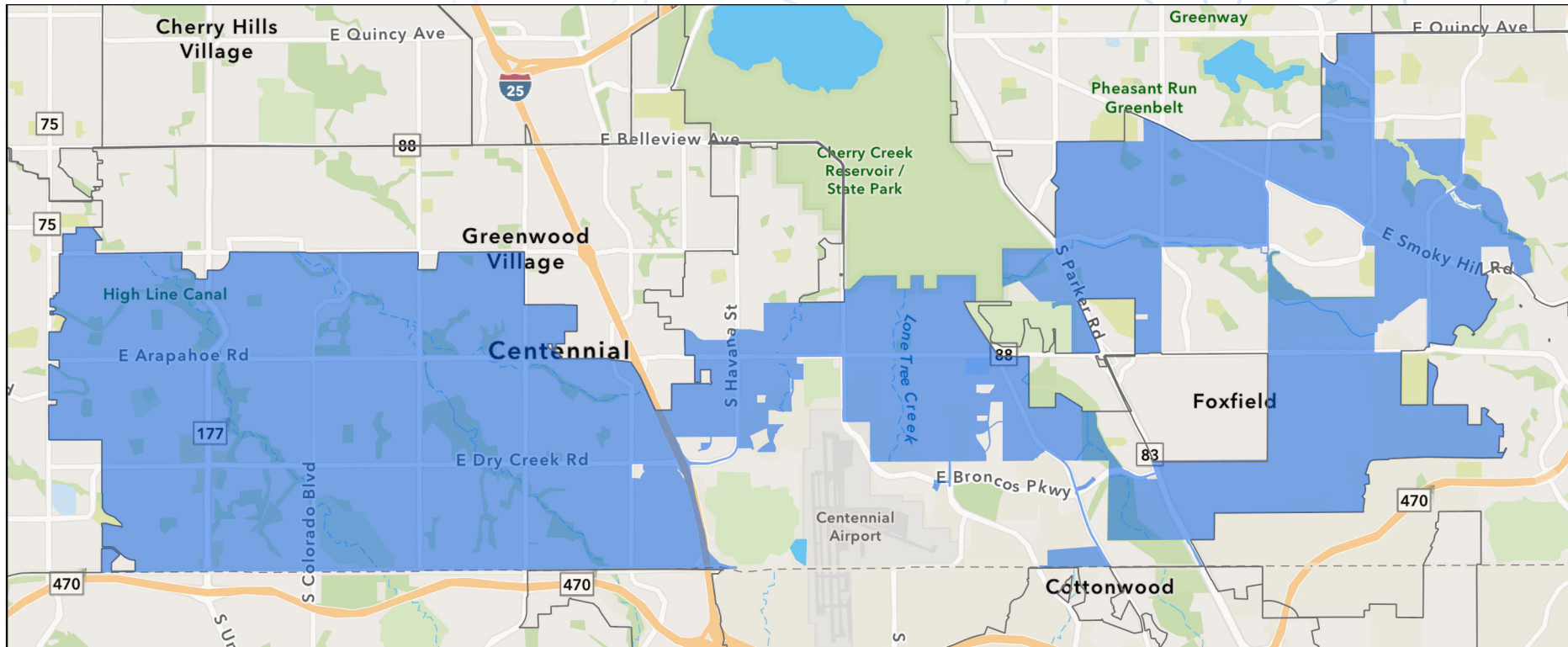

The Centennial Center Park Master Plan will guide the design and phasing for future expansion.

Centennial has created an Energy Action Plan in partnership with Xcel Energy outlining tangible steps for energy efficiency in the community.



The Interaction Lab at Southglenn Library educates visitors about applying universal design principles in their homes and was made possible by Centennial's partnership with Arapahoe Libraries.

Centennial has executed three dark fiber lease agreements with Ting Fiber, Cherry Creek School District and SEAKR Engineering.



The Denver Business Journal ranked Arapahoe High School, Cherry Creek High School and Grandview High School in the top 25 Colorado STEM high schools for 2019.

Centennial is implementing an integrated communications system that connects the City's fiber network and Traffic Operations Center.

Centennial continues to partner with the cities of Greenwood Village and Lone Tree to reduce traffic congestion on Yosemite Street between Lincoln Avenue and Bellevue Avenue.

FISCAL SUSTAINABILITY



Centennial offers a variety of sponsored community events including Summer Kickoff, Brew-N-Que: BBQ & Beer Tasting Festival, Under the Stars: Concert & Laser Light Show, Car Show and Chalk Art Festival.

The Unified Metropolitan Forensic Crime Laboratory opened in 2018 and is the result of partnerships among Arapahoe and Douglas Counties, the City of Aurora and the 18th Judicial District.

Centennial's City Council recently approved funding for a new Behavioral Health Response Program and 21 additional full-time employees at the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office.

South Metro Fire Rescue's new Station 32 was built for the community and our future in mind and is currently home to 7 Firefighters and 4 emergency vehicles. The facility can accommodate an additional 5 personnel and additional vehicles which will likely be needed in the years to come as emergency call volumes increase.

The Centennial Active Seniors program was established in 2018 by the Centennial Senior Commission to offer free, engaging programs for seniors in our community. In 2018, Centennial Active Seniors provided 12 events serving a total of 519 seniors.
