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## Transportation Resource Guide

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### INTRODUCTION

The City of Centennial's Senior Commission created the Mobility Ambassador Program (MAP) to assist the community with navigating transit options in the Denver Metro Area. This document serves as a comprehensive guide for Centennial users of transit, detailing how to plan a trip, how to use different transportation services, and start-to-end trip plans for various destinations including the Denver Zoo, the Colorado State Capitol, and many more.

The Transportation Resource Guide will direct readers to the use of specific smartphone applications (apps). Readers of this resource guide may want to have access to a smart phone in order to take full advantage of the information provided.

This guide will explain the process of downloading and using the following smartphone apps: GoDenver, Lyft, and Uber. Apps can be found in either the App Store application on an iPhone, or in the Google Play Store application on an Android device.


# Go Denver App

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
## OVERVIEW

Go Denver, powered by Xerox, is an app, that lets users plan trips in the Denver Metro area from start to finish. The app will show the available transportation modes, travel times, arrival times, trip costs, calories burned and carbon emissions.

Go Denver does not provide transportation services, but it is a great resource to find the best transportation option for your individual trip.




## GETTING STARTED

Note: iPhones will request a password to download apps.







2. Open the Go Denver app.

Note: You may be required to enter an email address to continue.





3. Select the three bars in the top left corner to open the Go Denver Menu.







4. Selecting, "Settings" will open up a menu that allows you to customize the settings to your specific needs and preferences.

For example, you may be interested in changing your walking speed and Max. Walk Time (the maximum amount of time you prefer to walk). These selections will impact the walking options Go Denver presents.







5. Select, "Transport". This will open a new screen that allows you to select which modes of transit you would like the app to suggest for your use.

The options with the colored (green or pink) tabs will be included, but you will not be shown transportation modes with gray tabs.





6. Select, "Done", then select the back arrow at the top left to return to the "Ride Now" screen.







## PLANNING A TRIP

1. Identify your starting location. If your GPS is turned on, the Go Denver app will find your location automatically. Always check to make sure the location that the app has identified is correct. You may also manually type in your beginning location and end-of-trip destination addresses.




2. Select the time you'll be leaving for your trip. If you would like to plan a trip that you'll be taking in the future, select, "Leave Now" located next to the clock icon. You can then adjust the settings to the time you'll be leaving.

Here, you can set the time by either the time you would like to leave for your trip or the time you would like to arrive to your destination.

Select, "Done" to return to the "Ride Now" page.







3. Selecting, "Route" will bring up a list of the available transportation options.

This screen includes information on your departure time, arrival time, travel time, price, CO2 emissions and calories burned.

4. Select one of the trip options for more information.

This page will allow you to see detailed maps. Selecting the arrow by the walking map will launch a map that shows turn-by-turn walking directions.

Note: You'll need to buy a ticket at the light rail station or on the bus if you plan to take these modes.



## OVERVIEW

Lyft is a national transportation company that connects passengers to affordable and convenient rides. You can request a ride in their app, and a Lyft driver from your community will arrive to give you a ride to your destination.

## HOW TO PAY FOR A RIDE


Users of Lyft pay for their rides within the app using their smartphone. When your Lyft ride is over, a screen will appear that allows you to select a card to pay with. The cost of a Lyft ride is based on the distance of the trip, total travel time, base charge (the amount the ride starts at), a service fee (added to each ride), and sometimes Prime Time pricing. Prime Time pricing is a percentage added to the ride cost during the busiest times, and you'll be notified of this additional cost before requesting your ride.

## SAFETY


Lyft conducts DMV and background checks on all drivers and maintains a zero-tolerance drug and alcohol policy. Vehicles cannot be more than 12 years old and must receive a 19-point inspection. In addition, all trips are covered by a \$1 million insurance policy. If you experience an incident, please contact 911 if necessary, then call Lyft Critical Response at 855-865-9553.

## ACCESSIBILITY

Lyft requires drivers to accommodate service animals and folding wheelchairs. It is recommended to call your driver **directly using the "Contact" button** to make the driver aware of any needs or required pickup accommodations.


2. Open the Lyft app, and select, "Sign Up".

Lyft will then ask you for an email address and phone number that you can be reached at.

Next, Lyft will text a verification code to the phone number you provided. Enter the verification code into the Lyft app to finish registration.







## REQUESTING A RIDE

1. Identify your current location. You can either manually type in your address, or Lyft will automatically identify your location if your GPS is turned on. Always make sure your address is identified correctly.





2. Select the kind of car you would like to ride in. Lyft offers three different types: Lyft Line - This car may stop to pick up other riders along your route in addition to you and your party. As a result, the ride is cheaper. You can have a maximum of two passengers in your party. Lyft - A ride for one party of up to four people. Lyft Plus - A larger vehicle for a party of up to six passengers.




3. Identify your destination. You can type in an exact address or search for a location.

After entering a destination, select, "Price Estimate" to learn how much the trip will cost.

The payment source can also be changed by selecting the "Apple Pay" or "Credit Card" button.





4. Request your Lyft. Once you select, "Request Lyft," a ride will be called to your pickup location. The time in the purple circle shows the expected time until your Lyft arrives.




Once you are matched with a driver, you will see a screen with the arrival time, vehicle type and license plate, as well as a photo of the driver, their name and rating.

If you need to contact your driver directly, you may do so by selecting the "Contact" button.

The car icon will move with the driver as they near your location, allowing you to see when the car is close or waiting outside.

## PAYMENT & RATING

After your ride, you will be able to tip and rate your driver 1-5 stars. If you rate a driver 3 stars or fewer, you will never be matched with that driver again.

# UBER

## Uber App

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### OVERVIEW

Uber is a convenient, inexpensive and safe taxi service. Riders use their app to request a ride, and an Uber driver arrives to take drivers to their destination.

### HOW TO PAY FOR A RIDE


Users of Uber pay for their rides within the app using their smartphone. After your Uber ride, a calculated amount is charged to the payment source you have designated. The cost of an Uber ride is based on the distance of the trip, total travel time and the base fare (the amount the ride starts at). Surge Pricing may also affect the price of your ride. **When there are more riders than drivers, Uber increases prices to encourage more drivers.** If Surge Pricing is in effect, you will see the increased rate before you book your trip.

### SAFETY


Uber conducts DMV and background checks on all of its drivers. Vehicles cannot be more than 15 years old and must receive an inspection. In addition, all trips are covered by a \$1 million insurance policy. If you experience an incident, please contact 911 if necessary, then use the Help function in the Uber app menu.

### ACCESSIBILITY

Uber requires drivers to accommodate riders with service animals, wheel chairs, and other assistive devices. It is recommended to call your driver directly using the "Contact" button to make the driver aware of any needs or required pickup accommodations.





## REQUESTING A RIDE

1. Identify your current location. You can either manually type in your address, or Uber will automatically identify your location if your GPS is turned on. Always make sure your address is identified correctly.

2. Next, select the type of Uber car you would like to request.

Uber offers several different options, including:


UberX - "Everyday cars for everyday use." These are regular, 4-passenger vehicles at low prices. UberX vehicles are from the year 2001 or newer.

UberXL - These are low-cost rides for up to 6 passengers. Vehicles must be 2001 or newer.


UberSELECT - These are slightly nicer vehicles with slightly higher prices. Vehicles seat 4 and must be newer than 2007 with leather interiors.

UberBLACK - These are high-end luxury sedans with higher fares. Vehicles must seat 4 and be newer than 2010. The drivers are required to have commercial registration, and riders can expect a higher level of service.

UberSUV - These are high-end luxury SUVs with the highest fares. Vehicles must seat 6 and be newer than 2010. The drivers are required to have commercial registration, and riders can expect a higher level of service.




3. Select, "Set Pickup Location", then identify your destination. You can type in an exact address or search for a location.

After entering a destination, select, "Fare Estimate" to learn how much the trip will cost.

The payment source can also be changed by selecting the credit card icon.







4. Once you select, "Request Uber", a ride will be called to your pickup location. The time in the location pin shows the expected amount of time until your Uber arrives.

Note: You may cancel a ride after requesting one, but may be charged a cancellation fee.




Once you are matched with a driver, you will see your driver's photo and name, expected arrival time, vehicle type and license plate.

You can swipe up from the bottom of the screen for additional options. Selecting, "Contact" will allow you to call the driver.

The car icon will move with the driver, allowing you to see when the car is near or waiting outside.

## PAYMENT & RATING

After your ride, you will be able to rate your driver 1-5 stars. Tips are not included in the fare, nor are they required. You are welcome, but not required, to tip your driver with cash.



# RTD Light Rail Transit

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## DIRECTIONS TO DRY CREEK STATION

From Eastbound Dry Creek Road, veer right to enter the station area between S. Chester Rd and I-25.

Once you enter, follow signs to RTD parking. You will briefly drive on the left side of the ramp to access the top floor of the parking garage. You can park in any space not labeled “reserved” once you arrive.



## PARKING


Parking at the Dry Creek Light Rail Station is free for 24 hours for vehicles registered in RTD's district, which includes all of Centennial. If your vehicle is registered elsewhere, you can use this website to look up your license plate to determine if you are in or out of the RTD district:

1. Look for the parking kiosk.
2. Enter your license plate number.
3. Enter the amount of time you will be parked for.
4. If payment is required, insert credit card.
5. The machine will print a receipt. The receipt does not need to be placed in your car; you may keep it with you.



# NAVIGATING THE LIGHT RAIL SYSTEM



This is the map of all RTD Light Rail routes. You can find this map online and at any light rail station. The Go Denver App is an excellent resource for planning your light rail trip and learning which line to take.

# TICKETING

The gray circles in the background of the map delineate fare zones A, B and C. If you are taking the light rail through one to two zones, you will need to purchase a local ticket. If you are taking the light rail through all three zones, you will need to purchase a regional ticket.

1. Look for the Ticket kiosk.
2. Using the RTD map, determine whether you need a local or regional ticket.
3. If you are in a hurry, select the Quick Ticket option. This will purchase a regional day pass.
4. If you need a local pass, select "Purchase Tickets".
5. Then select local or regional depending on your need.
6. Choose the number of tickets required.
7. Insert credit card.
8. If required, push button for receipt.

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## OVERVIEW

RTD offers several travel options for seniors and people with disabilities. This section offers information on three of RTD's programs, including SeniorRide, Access – A - Ride and Access – A - Cab.



# SeniorRide

## TRANSIT SERVICE FOR THE SENIOR CITIZEN COMMUNITY

Serving groups of ten or more people, SeniorRide is an essential service for the senior citizen community. Every year, SeniorRide transports thousands of senior citizens to a variety of cultural, educational and entertainment events.

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### HOW TO:

- Make a reservation by calling or sending an email: 303-299-6503 or [senior.ride@rtd-denver.com](mailto:senior.ride@rtd-denver.com)
- Mail one check for the group to the location indicated on the designated event pages before the deadline listed in the newsletter. Cash payment is not accepted
- Call in for final confirmations at least three weeks before the event. SeniorRide will provide information on pick-up times approximately one week before the event.

# Access – A – Ride

## PROVIDING TRAVEL OPTIONS FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES IN COLORADO

Access – a – Ride provides local bus transportation in the Denver metro area for people with disabilities. Access – a – Ride helps individuals who cannot access the fixed-routes bus and rail system to maintain their freedom to travel around the metro area.

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### ELIGIBILITY:

- ✓ Be unable to get to and from a bus stop or on and off a lift-equipped bus by yourself
- ✓ Have a cognitive disability that prohibits your understanding of how to complete bus trips

\*\* As part of the certification process, you must complete a functional evaluation in person and provide a physician's statement to verify your disability

### FARES:

Local (one-way): \$4.70

Regional (one-way): \$8.50

Airport (one-way to DIA): \$17.50

# Access – A – Cab

## PROVIDING TRAVEL OPTIONS FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES IN COLORADO

Access – A – Cab is a service eligible to Access – A – Ride passengers and is offered as a same day alternative service. It is a regular cab service but more readily available for persons who need a vehicle for wheelchairs or scooters.

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### ELIGIBILITY:

- ✓ Be unable to get to and from a bus stop or on and off a lift-equipped bus by yourself
- ✓ Have a cognitive disability that prohibits your understanding of how to complete bus trips

\*\* As part of the certification process, you must complete a functional evaluation in person and provide a physician's statement to verify your disability

### FARES:

The passenger pays the first \$2.00 of the fare; RTD pays the next \$12. The passenger is responsible for any amount over \$14.00. Five-Ride or Ten-Ride tickets will not be accepted as fare for Access – A – Cab trips.

# Start-to-End Trip Plans


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## RTD to UNION STATION

1. Get to Dry Creek Station, Arapahoe at Village Center Station or County Line Station.
  - a. (see attached process maps)
  - b. Enter license plate into parking kiosk if using Park-n-Ride.
2. Purchase regional day pass.
  - a. \$9.00 standard fare
  - b. \$4.50 for people 65+, with disabilities and Medicare recipients
  - c. One ticket is required for each traveler.
3. Take E line north-bound to Union Station (purple line on RTD map).
  - a. The trip takes approximately 35 minutes from the Dry Creek Station.
4. Union station is the final stop for the E line. An intercom announcement will ask all passengers to exit the train.
5. The train lets out ¼ mile from the iconic Union Station Terminal Building.
6. If you would like to access the Union Station Terminal Building, look for the glass enclosure and take the escalator downstairs.  
(Elevators are also available.)
  - a. Walking through RTD's underground bus terminal is more convenient and safer than walking on the street.
  - b. At the end of the bus depot, there is an up escalator that will place you right outside the entrance to Union Station.



## RTD to COORS FIELD

1. Get to Dry Creek Station, Arapahoe at Village Center Station or County Line Station.
  - a. (see attached process maps)
  - b. Enter license plate into parking kiosk if using Park-n-Ride.
2. Purchase regional day pass.
  - a. \$9.00 standard fare
  - b. \$4.50 for people 65+, with disabilities and Medicare recipients
  - c. One ticket is required for each traveler.
3. Take E line north-bound to Union Station (purple line on RTD map).
  - a. The trip takes approximately 35 minutes from the Dry Creek Station.
4. Union station is the final stop for the E line. An intercom announcement will ask all passengers to exit the train.
5. The train lets out ½ mile from Coors Field.
  - a. After exiting the train, look for the glass enclosure and take the escalator downstairs. (Elevators are also available.)
  - b. Walk through RTD's underground bus depot.
  - c. At the end of the bus depot, an escalator will take you up to the door of Union Station.
  - d. Walk through the iconic Union Station Terminal Building and exit onto the Union Station Plaza.
  - e. Turn left on Wynkoop St.
  - f. Wynkoop St will turn into a pedestrian-only pathway.
  - g. A pedestrian bridge crosses over 20<sup>th</sup> street and ends at the Left Field entrance to Coors Field.



## RTD to MILE HIGH STADIUM

1. Get to Dry Creek Station, Arapahoe at Village Center Station or County Line Station.
  - a. (see attached process maps)
  - b. Enter license plate into parking kiosk if using Park-n-Ride
2. Purchase regional day pass.
  - a. \$9.00 standard fare
  - b. \$4.50 for people 65+, with disabilities and Medicare recipients
  - c. One ticket is required for each traveler.
3. Take E line north-bound to Union Station (purple line on RTD map).
4. Exit the train at Sports Authority at Mile High Station.
  - a. The trip takes approximately 30 minutes from the Dry Creek Station.
5. The train lets out ½ mile from Sports Authority at Mile High Stadium.
  - a. After exiting the train, the easiest way to find the Stadium is to follow the crowd.



1. Get to Dry Creek Station, Arapahoe at Village Center Station or County Line Station.
  - a. (see attached process maps)
  - b. Enter license plate into parking kiosk if using Park-n-Ride
2. Purchase regional day pass.
  - a. \$9.00 standard fare
  - b. \$4.50 for people 65+, with disabilities and Medicare recipients
  - c. One ticket is required for each traveler.
3. Take F line north-bound to 18<sup>th</sup> and California (red line on RTD map).
4. Exit the train at the Theatre District & Convention Center Station.
  - a. The trip takes approximately 35 minutes from the Dry Creek Station.
5. The train lets out ¼ mile from the Performing Arts Complex.
  - a. Exit the train station towards 14<sup>th</sup> St.
  - b. Turn Left on 14<sup>th</sup> St.
  - c. In two blocks, the Performing Arts Complex will be on your left.





  - a. The trip takes approximately 35 minutes from the Dry Creek Station.
5. The train lets out 0.7mile from the Capitol building.
  - a. Stay on the same side of street to get on the Free 16<sup>th</sup> Street Mall Ride
  - b. Get off Mall Ride at Civic Center Station
  - c. Walk East towards Lincoln St.
  - d. Take a right on Sherman St. and you will see the Colorado State Capitol Building
