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REQUIRED PROPERTY OWNER YARD SIGN PLACEMENT PERMISSIONS (may be copied for additional pages)

By signing here, you are granting permission for a traffic safety awareness sign to be placed in your unfenced front or side yard (one sign per yard) on your residence property at least 5 feet back from the property line (typically edge of the sidewalk adjacent to the property, if one exists) and City right of way and in accordance with City Land Development Code, Article 6, Division 5. City staff can assist with placement questions as needed. You acknowledge that signs will be present for a maximum of 7-10 days in order to remind drivers that they are in a neighborhood and should behave accordingly. The novelty and visual impact of a row of temporary safety signs can help re-focus active attention and awareness, which enhances safe driving behaviors. You also acknowledge that the signs will remain the property of the City and must be returned to the Neighborhood Champion(s) at the conclusion of the approved deployment period.
