SHALL THE CITY OF CENTENNIAL TAXES BE INCREASED \$7,350,000 ANNUALLY, AND BY WHATEVER ADDITIONAL AMOUNT IS RAISED BY THE IMPOSITION OF AN ADDITIONAL 1% CITY SALES AND USE TAX, AND SHALL ALL REVENUES GENERATED FROM THE USE TAX ON VEHICLES BE RESTRICTED TO TRANSPORTATION MAINTENANCE AND PROJECTS, AND 50% OF THE REVENUES, NOT TO EXCEED \$2,800,000 ANNUALLY, TO BE GENERATED FROM 1% SALES TAX INCREASED BE RESTRICTED TO TRANSPORTATION AND DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE AND PROJECTS RESULTING IN A TOTAL SALES AND USE TAX RATE OF 2.5% WITHOUT EXEMPTING VEHICLES FROM THE USE TAX, EXCEPT THAT ALL SALES AND PURCHASES THAT MAY BE EXEMPTED FROM THE SALES TAX PURSUANT TO SECTION 29-2-105(1)(D), C.R.S. SHALL BE EXEMPTED, AND SHALL SUCH SALES AND USE TAX COMMENCE JANUARY 1, 2004 AND CONTINUE IN EFFECT UNTIL REPEALED IN CONFORMANCE WITH ORDINANCE NO. 2003-O-20; TO BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT, AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE, OFFSET AND EXCEPTION TO THE LIMITS WHICH WOULD OTHERWISE APPLY UNDER TABOR (ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION) OR ANY OTHER LAW?
