

Summary

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by age, sex, race/ethnicity, housing tenure (rent or own) and housing type (attached or detached).

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as “excellent” or “good,” or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A “p-value” of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between subgroups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are “real.” Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for this report is generally no greater than plus or minus four percentage points around any given percent reported for the entire sample (484 completed surveys). For subgroups of responses, the margin of error increases because the sample size for the subgroup is smaller. For subgroups of approximately 100 respondents, the margin of error is plus or minus 10 percentage points.

Notable differences between demographic subgroups included the following:

- Within general aspects of Community Characteristics, female residents, those who were white and non-Hispanic and those living in detached homes tended to give more positive ratings to Centennial as a place to raise children. When differences were significant within other facets of this pillar, female residents were more likely to give excellent or good ratings compared to their male counterparts, including feeling safe in their neighborhoods, ease of travel by car, public places where people want to spend time, overall economic health of Centennial, overall opportunities for education and enrichment and opportunities to participate in social events, volunteer and participate in community matters. For all aspects of Built Environment, individuals who lived in attached housing tended to give lower ratings, such as the availability of affordable quality housing and overall quality of new development in Centennial, than those who lived in detached housing.
- Younger residents (18-34) tended to give higher ratings to most aspects of Governance, including overall confidence in Centennial government, street maintenance and repair, sidewalk maintenance, street resurfacing, City open space, land use, planning and zoning, code enforcement, economic development and Centennial parks than their counterparts. However, ratings for traffic enforcement were rated higher by residents over the age of 35.
- Participants who were younger, male residents and those who lived in attached housing were less likely to recommend living in Centennial or to report they had contacted the City in the 12 months prior to the survey. Younger residents (18-34) were more likely to report they had visited a neighborhood or City park, participated in moderate or vigorous physical activity, were in very good or excellent health and attended a City-sponsored event; however, older residents (55+) were more likely report they had participated in measures related to Community Engagement, including having contacted Centennial elected officials, attended a public meeting and read or watched local news. Residents who were Hispanic and/or another race and participants under the age of 55 reported higher rates of optimism that the economy will have a positive impact on income.
- Female residents were more likely to give ratings of high importance to most of the strategic planning areas that contribute to the overall quality of life in Centennial. Residents who owned their own homes and those who lived in detached housing tended to give higher ratings to sense of community as a strategic planning area than other respondents.
- Survey respondents who were female tended to give more positive ratings to the quality of services not provided by the City of Centennial.
- Centennial residents who were between the ages of 35 and 54 were more likely to report that they felt children were very or somewhat safe while attending school than their counterparts.
